## Demonstration Series 2009

As part of the **NWS 89th Annual Exhibition**, five nationally known watercolor masters will demonstrate their painting techniques at the City of Brea Art Gallery.

### **Stephen Quiller** Sunday, Oct. 11, 2009, 10:00 AM to 3:00 PM

Stephen Quiller will demonstrate his use of watercolor and casein mixed media, using a subject from the high country of Colorado, where he resides.

Stephen Quiller has been painting full time since 1972. He lives and operates the Quiller Gallery in Creede, Colorado. He is a member of many watercolor societies, including AWS, NWS, the Rocky Mountain National Water Media and the National Society for Painters in Acrylic and Casein. He has written six books on color and watermedia, including *Color Choices*, *Painter's Guide to Color*, *Acrylic Painting Techniques* and his new book, *Watermedia Painting with Stephen Quiller*. He has won many awards, including the 2009 Nicholas Reale Memorial Award, Hal P. Moore Award and the Louis Keep Award. He has done 12 educational videos and DVDs for Crystal Productions and the Jack Richeson Company.



### **Gerald Brommer** Saturday, Oct. 17, 2009, 10:00 AM to 3:00 PM

Gerald Brommer will address several important aspects of painting, including content, editing, sequencing, communication and even painting. There will be a demonstration, discussions, slides to view, and some important conclusions to draw.

Gerald Brommer is completely involved in art as an innovative watercolor and acrylic painter, collagist, teacher, author and juror. He is a life member and past president of NWS and is honorary president of the National Association of Painters in Acrylic, as well as belonging to many watercolor organizations. He has won awards in most national competitive watercolor shows and has had over 165 one man shows in galleries and colleges from Alaska to Florida. His work and articles have appeared in many books as well as in national and international magazines such as *American Artist* and *International Artist*.



### **Yachiyo Beck** Saturday, Oct. 24, 2009, 10:00 AM to 3:00 PM

Yachiyo Beck will demonstrate her unique style of still life with an abstract background. She will show paintings in each of the three stages: beginning, middle and finished and how she progresses in each stage. She will use slides to enhance her presentation.

Yachiyo Beck's passion for art has been an enduring force in her life. Her sources of inspiration include personal experiences, nature, and her own artistic imagination. A distinct Asian influence is present in many of her paintings. Her work has been featured in *American Artist* and *Watercolor Magazine*. She has participated in many juried shows and frequently wins awards, including the 2008 AWS Margery Soroka Memorial Award. She is a Signature Member of NWS and her work has been displayed in the NWS Annual Show, the Traveling Show and the All Member show many times.



### **Chris Van Winkle** Saturday, Nov 7, 2009, 10:00 AM to 3:00 PM

Using one of his sketches, Chris Van Winkle will demonstrate how he brings a painting to life. In a loose painterly style he will create a colorful, impressionistic and highly exciting work.

Chris is a California artist with roots in Canada. He has studied extensively with Robert Hallett, with the legendary Milford Zornes, Robert E. Wood, Frank Webb, George James and Henry Fukuhara. For the past 21 years Chris has been teaching watercolor at Citrus College. He has conducted workshops in California, traveled and painted throughout the United States and Canada, and has led painting trips to Spain, Holland, Britain, Middle Europe and Russia. He was selected as one of the "top twenty" art instructors by *Watercolor Magazine*. Chris is an award-winning artist and signature member of both NWS and Watercolor West, as well as a signature member of the Transparent Watercolor Society of America and the Whiskey Painters of America. Chris has served several years on the board of the NWS, and as president for three years.

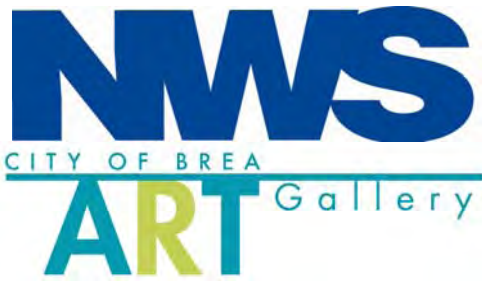


### **Brenda Swenson** Saturday, Nov 14, 2009, 10:00 AM to 3:00 PM

She is an active participant in the arts community having served on the board of directors for both NWS and Watercolor West. Swenson has received many awards for her paintings and is in demand to demonstrate and teach her painting and sketching techniques to groups nationwide and abroad.

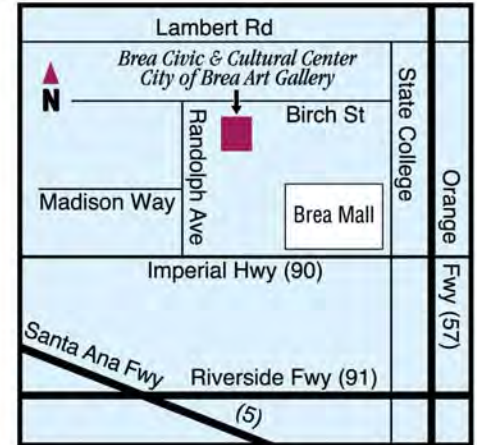
